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# Chambolle-Musigny

This Chambolle-Musigny village, formerly known as «Orveaux des Bussières,» is a blend of two plots.

One of them was planted in the early 1900s and rests on a soil rich in marl and clay, providing deep rooting for the vines.

The other plot, on the other hand, has a higher proportion of pebbles and outcropping rocks.

Produced from very old vines, this wine expresses great aromatic complexity.

Thanks to the nature of its soil and the age of its vines, it reveals a remarkable depth of texture, characterized by exceptional density and richness.



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### Tasting notes

The subtle aroma is defined by the essence of red cherry liqueur subtly intertwined with hints of spice, violet, and rose petal. The palate boasts highly dynamic flavours, leading to a lingering final characterized by fine-grained tannins.



The 2017 wine year is distinguished by its superlative generosity. Following a dry and cold winter, the spring proved mild and rain-free. The vines enjoyed pleasant weather conditions, with temperatures up to 6°C above the norm. The summer, marked by warm and dry weather, contributed to the fruit achieving

an ideal state of health. Yields were very generous, and after reducing yields through «green harvesting,» the optimal ripeness of the grapes led to the harvest beginning on September 7th.

The wines from the 2017 vintage are elegant and refined, with a beautiful tension, silky tannins, and great aromatic complexity.
